# Overview of CTO appointment

### First appointment process

- Cabinet agreed [CBC-17-MIN-0078] to the creation of the CTO role in December 2017. Paper
  was jointly developed by DIA, MBIE, and SSC with support from the Treasury. This included a
  Terms of Reference that formed the basis for the original advertisement.
- Recruitment began on 19 December 2017, with applications closing on 15 January 2018.
- Officials considered the sixty-one applicants against a matrix of criteria. Eighteen candidates were longlisted.
- The longlist was reviewed by a panel composed of f(z)(a) = g(z)(a) ws, g(z)(a) and g(z)(a) = 1 in January 2018. Panellist background is as follows:

- Panellists arranged for exploratory conversations with a small group of candidates to further consider aspects of their experience and / or their proposed approach to the role.
- The panel came together in a teleconference facilitated by officials from DIA and MBIE, and
  arrived at a shortlist that was forwarded to Hon Curran. From that list, three were chosen for
  interview. Roger Dennis was unable to attend the teleconference at short notice due to
  bereavement, but provided his advice through to DIA, which was then shared with the panel.
- The interview panel consisted of Hon Curran, Andrew Kibblewhite as Chief Executive of DPMC, and Rob Carr from the PMO.
- At the same time, work was underway by DIA and MBIE as an exception to the Cabinet Fees
  Framework was required. Support was provided by SSC in this, which included work to seek
  independent advice on the size of the role from management consulting firm Korn Ferry. This
  was completed in February 2018 and the exception was approved by Hon Hipkins on 12
  February 2018.
- On 12 February 2018 Minister Curran announced no appointment would be made, and that the newly formed Digital Economy and Digital Inclusion Ministerial Advisory Group (DEDI) would provide advice on the job description and consider how to identify the best candidate for the job.

### Second appointment process

- In March and April, work began to refine the job description with the support of Hon Curran's DEDI advisory group.
- In April 2018 the group provided advice and the job description, including the proposed length of tenure, was amended.
- The role description was narrowed and the appointment period was set out as one year with an
  option to renew to acknowledge that different skills would be required to carry out the role
  through different phases from start-up through to implementation.
- Joint advice from MBIE and DIA was provided to the Minister through this period.
- The role was re-advertised in May 2018, closing in June 2018.
- DIA and MBIE promoted the role domestically and internationally.
- A joint briefing (DIA and MBIE) was provided to Hon Curran with options about how she might
  conduct the appointment, and DPMC also had input into this through \(\frac{1}{2}\) as the PAG advisor.
- Longlisting of the seventy-two applicants followed this process:
  - o Applicants were longlisted by MBIE and DIA officials; each candidate's application was reviewed by two to three officials
  - Applicants were longlisted by Ms Francis Valintine (Chair, Digital Economy and Digital Inclusion Ministerial Advisory Group [DEDI])
  - Hon Curran endorsed a final longlist of 18.
- Shortlisting followed a two-step process:
  - Longlisted candidates were contacted to provide written answers and video responses to a set of questions created by officials and reviewed by DEDI subcommittee members.
  - Videos and written answers were reviewed by six DEDI Ministerial Advisory Group subcommittee members.
  - The subcommittee members met in June 2018, and recommended eight candidates proceed to shortlisting.
  - The eight candidates provided a video pitch, outlining an answer to this question: "If you were facing the media for the first time as the Chief Technology Officer, what would your pitch be and what would you name as your immediate priorities?"
- The interview steps followed this process:
  - Hon Curran, Ms Valintine,  $\P(2)(1)$  from Prime Minister's Office, and Mr Colin MacDonald (as Government Chief Digital Officer) reviewed the candidate's materials, including pitch video  $\P(2)(3)$  and idates were selected to proceed to interview.
  - o After the interviews, Hon Curran, Ms Valintine, (2)(2), and Mr MacDonald selected and apability testing.
  - Hon Curran made her decision with the support of the panel, and this was confirmed by the Prime Minister in August 2018.
- Due diligence and conflicts of interest approach
  - SSC provided advice about due diligence, and this was provided to Hon Curran in July 2018.



- Further and more detailed advice was taken from DPMC about the setup of the Chief Science Advisor role in consideration of how best to provide support for an incoming CTO.
- The APH paper was developed jointly with MBIE with the support of their appointments team and had input from SSC and DPMC.
- The candidate has provided verbal agreement to a letter of appointment and contract, ...


