

This page reports only on the complaints received by Novopay and the Ministry regarding no pays, underpayments and overpayments between 5 January to 9 January (the week of the payment for pay period 21).

Key summary metrics:

Complaints had been received from a total of 61 schools (representing 2.52% of schools in the pay roll system).

Complaints relate to the pay for 66 staff from these schools (or 0.11% of the staff paid).
